REGARDING SUPPLEMENTATION OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY  
PROCEDURE FOR CONTRACTORS BDS-40**

I hereby:

1. **S u p p l e m e n t** Occupational Health and Safety Procedure for Contractors BDS-40 (hereinafter – Procedure BDS-40) approved with Order No TV1(1.2-1)-348 of 12 October 2017 issued by the Director of Quality, Labor Safety and Environmental Control of Public Company ORLEN Lietuva (hereinafter – the Company) with Par. 6.14 reading as follows:

'6.14. If total allowable weight of vehicle exceeds 3.5 tons or if the driver is not able to control the area behind the vehicle, reversing should be performed with hazard warning flashers on, at minimum possible speed, with someone's assistance and through the side mirrors carefully watching the area behind the vehicle and person assisting in reversing. It is recommended to have these vehicles equipped with sound reversing alarm to warn others that vehicle is moving in reverse. If vehicle is not equipped with such alarm, when moving in reverse, the driver must periodically push the horn of the vehicle to warn others.'

2. **E s t a b l i s h** that the present Order shall come into force on 15 November 2019.

3. **O b l i g a t e** the heads of organizational units of the Company listed in the Distribution Index hereof to familiarize their subordinates with the present Order by 14 November 2019.

4. **A s s i g n** the responsible employee of Executive Office to distribute this Order to the heads of organizational units of the Company.
